

Individual interview

1. Objectives of the interview

For each student, the interview aims to evaluate:

- their motivation to enter the CentraleSupélec - McGill Bachelor of Engineering in Global Engineering.
- their career goals (their motivation to become an engineer).
- their knowledge of the program's operation.
- their interest in international studies.

2. General evaluation criteria

- Work and commitment to the engineering orientation.
- Interest in science and technology.
- Demonstrated or shown interest in innovation response to issues related to SD (energy, transportation, technological developments to be rethought, etc.) and associated economic and societal issues.
- Understanding of the role of the engineer in society.
- Quick-wittedness.
- Uniqueness.
- Authenticity.
- Coherence of the application process.

3. Conduct of the interview (1 hour) by videoconference

The candidate is given a short text to read during the first half hour.

During the second half-hour, the candidate answers questions from a CentraleSupélec-McGill jury on their motivation to join the program and on the text provided at the beginning of the interview.
